1. This is to announce the conduct of Renewal and Reflection: An Inclusive Spiritual Enrichment Initiative for SDO Bulacan Personnel with the theme, "Embarking on the Journey to Jesus: A Unified Quest for Growth and Wisdom" on March 26, 2024, Tuesday, 6:30 am onwards, at Seven (7) Designated Roman Catholic Churches within the province of Bulacan (see attached list).
2. The abovementioned theme, encapsulates a profound invitation to each one of us to launch on a transformative spiritual journey towards deeper understanding, personal development, and spiritual enlightenment. This also highlights the collective pursuit of all concerned SDO Bulacan personnel towards a shared goal of seeking wisdom and growth in their faith.

4. Expected participants to this activity are SDO Bulacan's Top Management, Select Education Program and Public Schools District Supervisors, and personnel from CID, SGOD, and OSDS.
5. Expenses for meals relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against Division MOOE, while transportation shall be charged against any local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Health and safety protocols shall be strictly implemented and always observed.
7. This Memorandum will serve as travel authority of all the participants.
