DIVISION CAPACITY BUILDING FOR SCHOOL HEADS & CAREER STAGE 3-4 KINDER TEACHERS ON ENHANCING DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE PRACTICES: RESEARCH-BASED INTERACTIVE VIDEO LESSONS

1. Under Republic Act 10157 also known as the Kindergarten Education Act and the "Enhance Basic Education Act of 2013", mandatory and compulsory Kinder education that effectively promotes physical, social, cognitive, and emotional skills stimulation and values formation is offered to all five (5)- year old Filipino children.

Developmentally Appropriate Practices (DAP) through a research-based program is designed to empower Kindergarten teachers with the knowledge and skills to effectively integrate interactive video lessons into their classrooms. As well as crafting a research proposal on developmentally appropriate practices in teaching kinder learners to address their needs, interests and abilities.

In line with the progressive implementation of MATATAG Curriculum, the Department of Education, Schools Division of Bulacan, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall conduct Capacity Building for Highly Proficient Kindergarten Teachers on May 8-10, 2024 at Casa Cirila Resort Pavillion, Bulihan, Plaridel, Bulacan

- 2. The objectives of the activities are:
 - 2.1 To equip highly proficient kindergarten teachers (Career Stages 3 and 4) with the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed to deliver high-quality teaching using Developmentally Appropriate Practices through interactive video lessons;
 - 2.2 To create an interactive video lessons in the delivery of creative teaching;







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- 2.3 To craft and submit a research proposal on the use of the developmentally appropriate practices approach in teaching kindergarten;
- 2.4 To integrate simple online assessment for kindergarten; and
- 2.4 To demonstrate the integration of a technologically driven education in kindergarten.
- 3. The participants in this training are 2 School Heads, 2 Master Teachers/ 2 Teacher III in Kindergarten per district (6 participants per district). All participants are required to make a pre-registration using this link https://rb.gy/132uv7
- 4. Enclosure No. 1 contains the training matrix, list of resource speakers, list of participants, and work committees for reference.
- 5. All expenses incidental to the conduct of this capacity building shall be charged against Division INSET Funds while incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged from local or school/MOOE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedure.
- 6. All concerned are reminded to adhere to health and safety protocols during the training. All participants are required to bring a laptop, broadband, and extension cord.
