**ADVANCED CAMPUS JOURNALISM SIMULATION SESSIONS OF THE SDO BULACAN
QUALIFIERS TO THE 2024 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC)**

1. Apropos to the **BULAKENYO** Flagship Program of the Schools Division of Bulacan focusing on “Bringing all Bulakenyo school-age children to quality learning environment; Addressing the nature, situation, realities and needs of all learners; and Yielding to the prescribed standards to sustain the delivery of quality services through appropriate timely and relevant PPAs to uphold the holistic development of students,” principally in the field of Campus Journalism, this Office shall forefront on the conduct of the training-workshop titled “Advanced Campus Journalism Simulation Sessions of the SDO Bulacan Qualifiers to the 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)” to be held on May 14-15, 2024 at Montessori De Sagrada Familia, Inc., Tangos, Baliwag, Bulacan.
2. This co-curricular activity aims to:
 - 2.1 present the outputs of the previously conducted press conference sessions and contests;
 - 2.2 provide informative inputs on the progressive trends in campus journalism per Regional Memo No.214, s.2024; and
 - 2.3 conduct advanced simulation sessions to properly address the gaps in line with the journalistic skills.
3. Expected participants to this training-workshop are the Top 3 Winners in 9 Individual Writing Categories, and the Top 1 Winners in Radio-Broadcasting and Scriptwriting Contest, including the identified RSPC contestants in Collaborative Desktop and Online Publishing and TV Broadcasting, English and Filipino, Elementary and Secondary Levels.
4. Enclosure No.1 contains the matrix of activities and the Division Campus Journalism TWG Core Group/Speakers/Facilitators.
5. Teacher-coaches are expected to submit training development plans and schedule of sessions with their campus journalists to ensure that essential contact hours shall be devoted to other curricular activities and learning episodes prior to the end of School Year 2023-2024. Consequently, all school heads are reminded of the DepEd Order No. 9, S. 2005, “Instituting Measure to Increase Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.” Classes must not be disrupted and there must be substitutes to those attending the activity.
6. All learner-journalists must have parent’s/guardian’s letter of consent to be submitted to their teacher-coaches allowing them to join and participate in the said intensive trainings. Correspondingly, they should be given pertinent academic considerations during the training-workshop sessions to cope with their learning episodes.
7. Strictly, **no monetary and non-monetary fees** shall be taken from the parents and learners. Instead, all food and refreshments and snack expenses to be incurred in the conduct

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aforesaid training-workshop shall be charged to Provincial School Board Funds while the transportation and incidental expenses of the participants shall be taken from the Student Development Canteen Funds/MOOE/LSB/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. This Memorandum serves as travel authority of the persons involved during the conduct of the Campus Journalism activities.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
