- 1. Towards the goal of sharing effective techniques in the management of classroom structure, this Office announces that the Division Seminar on Pedagogies of Teaching through the Modified 4As Approach in connection with How Children Learn (HCL) and Multiple Intelligences (MIs) for Proficient Teachers is scheduled on May 21-23, 2024 (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) 8 AM 4PM @ Villa Emmanuela Wavepool Resort, Población I, Plaridel, Bulacan.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - 2.1. equip the participants with the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes in providing teaching learning approaches for diverse learners;
 - 2.2. capacitate them to become reflective on their teaching practices, and ensure that these practices are aligned with the learning styles and multiple intelligence of their learners; and
 - 2.3. develop their capacity to share acquired learning to beginning teachers via LAC session.
- 3. The participants in this activity are 110 proficient teachers from 31 districts of the SDO and 10 members of the technical work group. The names are enumerated in Enclosure 1 of this Memorandum. while Enclosure No. 2 contains the Training Matrix.
- 4. The expenses like meals and other incidental expenses of this activity shall be charged from INSET Fund while the transportation fares of the participants can be charged from school/canteen funds, both of which are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
