1. The Division Search for Best EGPP school Implementer is open to all public elementary and secondary schools in Schools Division of Bulacan, whether the school is recipient or non recipient of GPP financial assistance from DepEd Central office or with partnered NGAs or NGOs.
2. The search is composed of two categories.
 - a. Best EGPP-Project School Implementer in Elementary
 - b. Best EGPP-Project School Implementer in Secondary
3. Each EDDIS shall submit one (1) entry per category using google sheet that will provided on or before October 15, 2024.
4. Means of Verification (MOVs) as indicated in the criteria must be presented during the onsite validation to the Division Search Committee, otherwise no points shall be given. The criteria for search is attached in this Memorandum.
5. During the onsite validation, school is requested to prepare and present the 2023-2024 Gulayan sa Paaralan Program accomplishment report to Division Search Committee.
6. School with highest-garnered scores shall be declared as Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan (EGPP) Project Division Winner in each category and will represent the Schools Division of Bulacan for Regional Search for Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (EGPP)-Project GAME "Gulayan para sa Aktibong Mag-aaral ng Rehiyon Tatlo" School Implementers.
7. All Winners shall receive prizes and non- winning nominees shall receive a certificate of recognition as finalist. Cash Prize will be claimed at the Provincial Capitol to be coordinated by the School Governance and Operations Division- School Health Section of DepEd Bulacan.
