### SCHEDULE OF LEARNING ASSESSMENTS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

- 1. In line with DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2024: Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum and DepEd Order No. 8, s. 2015: Policy Guideline on Classroom Assessment for K to 12, Basic Education Program, this Office announces the administration of various assessments in all grade levels for the school year 2024-2025.
- 2. The said assessments shall be implemented and administered as prescribed minimum standards to all public and private schools.
- 3. The types of assessments are stated below;
