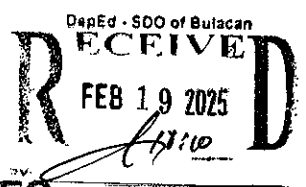

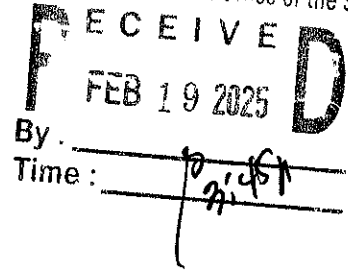

We are very glad to inform you that once again, the Girl Scouts of the Philippines—Bulacan Council, will have its **18th Junior and Senior Provincial Camp** with the theme *"Living the Promise, Leading with Purpose"* on **March 28 – 30, 2025** at **Jose Victor Alexis R. Sy-Alvarado's Paradise Farms, Brgy. Calumpang, San Miguel, Bulacan.**

The camp aims to:

- Facilitate opportunities among girls to share their unique experiences and perspective, fostering empathy and mutual respect.
- Create joint initiatives to promote equality and diversity.
- Create an environment where every individual is empowered to contribute talents and perspective towards a common goal.

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANTS:

The participants must be/have:

- Registered Junior / Senior / Cadet Girl Scouts
- Physically fit and alert
- Attended the Pre-Camp

PARTICIPANTS

- Minimum of 5 patrols or 40 **Junior Girl Scouts**
- Minimum of 12 **Junior Troop Leaders**
- Minimum of 5 patrols or 40 **Senior / Cadet Girl Scouts**
- Minimum of 12 **Senior Troop Leaders**

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:

Participants are advised to go at their time of convenience at **Jose Victor Alexis R. Sy-Alvarado's Paradise Farms, Brgy. Calumpang, San Miguel, Bulacan** for the registration, settling down, and camp development. The *Opening Ceremony* will be on **March 28, 2025** and the *Closing Ceremony* will be on **March 30, 2025**.

REGISTRATION FEE:

The event fee is **SEVEN HUNDRED PESOS (PHP 700.00)** per participant to cover accommodation, program materials, souvenirs, badges and activities. The registration fee and travel expenses must be charged to MOOE, LSB and other local school funds.

THINGS TO BRING:

These should be brought by the individual camper and packed in a duffle bag and a backpack/knapsack provided with luggage tags. Campers are encouraged to travel light and bring only what is needed.

Casual attire	Set of eating utensils (plastic, plate, saucer, cup, tumbler, spoon, fork, knife, cloth, napkin, glass—all of these to be placed in a drawstring bag)
Sweater / Jacket / Long Sleeves	Sunblock cream, insect repellent
Extra Shirts	Costume for camp fire
Sewing Kit	Prescribed medicines
Sleeping Garments / Slippers	Face towels and bath towel
Underwear	Whistle
	Glue Gun

Plastic Sheet for the grounds	Musical Instrument/s
Bolo / trowel	Powerbank

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IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The list of confirmed participants with their accomplished Application Form (Information Sheet), Parents' Consent, Health Declaration Form must be submitted to the Bulacan GSP Council Office on or before **MARCH 10, 2025**.
- **Two-day service credit** for **March 29-30, 2025**, must be granted to the Troop Leader participating in the camp.
- This memo will serve as **PARTICIPANTS' TRAVEL ORDER**
