**2ND FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSION – MEETING FOR THE PROJECT
TEACH-LEARN-AND-IMPROVE (USING KHAN ACADEMY AND
FRONTLEARNERS)**

1. To address the educational challenges highlighted by previous assessment results and to improve the overall quality of education, the Department of Education has faced significant challenges in reading, mathematics, and science, with learner performance lagging behind global standards. Hence, the department aims to; identify strengths and weaknesses by gaining insights into the current state of education and identify areas that need improvement; benchmark against global standards by comparing the performance of Filipino students with their peers worldwide to understand where they stand on a global scale; develop targeted interventions by using the data to create targeted interventions and policies that address specific educational needs and improve learning outcomes; enhance teacher training by improving teaching skills and methodologies to better prepare students for future assessments and real-world challenges; and, promote holistic development by fostering critical thinking, problem-solving, and decision-making skills in learners to prepare them for lifelong learning and active participation in society. To discuss this, there will be a Second Focus Group Discussion – Meeting for the **Project Teach-Learn-Improve (Using Khan Academy and FrontLearners)** on March 5, 2025, at 8:30 AM at the Conference Hall of the SDO Bulacan, Malolos City.
2. The following objectives are set to be attained:



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- provide continuous professional development for teachers to adopt innovative teaching methodologies and technologies; and
 - implement learner-centered pedagogical approaches to foster active learning and engagement.
3. Participants in this activity are selected 45 English, Math, and Science Teachers involved in this Project TLI, representatives from Dr. Felipe de Jesus National High School and Virginia Ramirez High School with the education program supervisors and members of the Technical Work Committee.
 4. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of all participants.
 5. Expenses to be incurred in this activity, such as meal expenses, shall be charged against Division MOOE, while transportation expenses can be charged against school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
