#### SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) FOR THE SUMMER LEARNING BOOST CAMP FY 2025

- 1. The Schools Division of Bulacan shall implement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for the Summer Learning Boost Camp FY 2025 from May 19 to June 6, 2025 pursuant to the OM-OUOPS-2025-08-02500 or the Third Advisory for the Implementation of the SBFP SY 2024-2025 which directs SDOs to proceed with the implementation of SBFP using the allotted funds for the NLC or other similar and/or alternative programs as guided by the instructions issued from the OM-OUOPS-2024-09-10424 or the First Advisory for the Implementation of SBFP FY 2025.
- 2. The program aims to:
  - Offer healthy and balanced meals to learners, enhancing their nutritional status and overall health; and
  - Improve learner's ability to learn and retain information, leading to better academic performance.
- 3. The beneficiaries of the program shall be the 14,891 participants of the Summer Learning Boost Camp from SDO Bulacan and SDO Baliwag.
- 4. The food products shall be delivered to the 32 identified drop-off points on a one-time delivery basis, and shall be inspected and monitored by the designated inspection team.
- 5. Nutritious Food Products (NFPs) shall be distributed daily for 14 days to the beneficiaries during the duration of the learning camp, while sterilized milk shall be provided for 2 days. Attached herewith is the 14-day NFP menu for reference.

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- 6. The following SBFP forms shall be accomplished by the schools and submitted to the Division Office:
  - Form 1 Masterlist of Beneficiaries
  - Form 3 Attendance of Daily Feeding
  - Form 5 Milk Component (Milk Intolerance)
  - Form 8 Milk Consent Form
- 7. Funds for the SBFP operational expenses shall be downloaded to schools based on the number of beneficiaries. The allocated operational allowance shall be utilized based on DO 31, s.2021 which provides the operational guidelines for the SBFP implementation.
- The Public Schools Division Supervisors and the School Health and Nutrition Unit personnel shall jointly monitor the implementation of the program.
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
