1. In line with one of the Department of Education's 5-point agenda: efficient learning delivery in all its forms, the implementation of the Revised K to 12 Curriculum in Key Stages 1, 2, and 3 and pursuant to the mandate of providing continuous professional development activity for our teachers, this Office announces the conduct of Division Orientation Training-Workshop of Core Training Faculty in the Preparation of the School-Based Training on the Revised K to 12 Curriculum for Grades 2, 3, 5 and 8 Teachers on June 2, 2025 at Sapientia Hall, Dr. Yanga's Colleges, Inc., Bocaue, Bulacan.
2. This training focuses on preparing and finalizing the training matrix, slide decks, and presentations on the school-based training in the Revised K to 12 Curriculum for Grades 2, 3, 5, and 8. Each participant will demonstrate strengthening facilitation techniques, deepening curriculum mastery, enhancing communication strategies, integrating instructional and digital tools, developing problem-solving skills, and fostering collaboration among facilitators to ensure effective curriculum implementation and continuous professional growth.
3. This activity aims to:
 - a. equip participants with appropriate pedagogical strategies and instructional approaches aligned with the revised curriculum to promote effective and engaging learning experiences.
 - b. encourage collaboration and knowledge-sharing among participants to ensure contextualized learner-centered implementation of the revised K to 12 Curriculum.
 - c. utilize appropriate instructional materials, digital tools, and interactive strategies for curriculum dissemination.

- 5. All participants should bring copies of the Revised K to 12 Curriculum Guides, a laptop, and an extension cord to be used in the training proper. Further, participants are also reminded to bring their Training Passports.
 - 6. All expenses incidental to the conduct of this Schools Division Orientation Training-Workshop shall be charged against the 2024 MATATAG Curriculum Fund, while incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to the local or school/MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
 - 7. Teacher participants shall be granted service credits according to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 on the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers
 - 8. It is expected that all participants observe the minimum health protocols to continuously prevent the spread of any infectious diseases.
 - 9. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority for all the participants and members of the technical working group of this activity.
