

EQUIPPING PRIVATE SCHOOL EDUCATORS FOR SY 2025-2026: MATATAG CURRICULUM PHASE 2 (G2358) TRAINING FOR GRADES 2, 3, 5, AND 8

Private School Teachers of Grades 2, 3, 5, and 8

1. In support of the MATATAG Curriculum implementation and in alignment with the nationwide rollout of Phase 2 (G2358), the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Bulacan shall facilitate a three-day division-led training exclusively for teachers of private schools under its jurisdiction who are handling Grades 2, 3, 5, and 8. The training will be held on June 9-11, 2025 at Jesus Is Lord Colleges Foundation (JILCF), Bocaue, Bulacan.
2. This Phase 2 training empowers private school teachers to implement the MATATAG Curriculum for Grades 2, 3, 5, and 8 with confidence and clarity. Through focused sessions on policy updates, shaping papers, and curriculum unpacking, participants will strengthen their ability to align pedagogy and assessment using contextualized Quarter 1 to 4 learning resources. The training also features collaborative activities inspired by Learning Action Cells (LAC), culminating in the development of a practical Workplace Application Plan (WAP) that supports sustained and effective classroom implementation.
3. A registration fee of ₱2,000.00 per participant will be collected by the BULPRISA organization to cover meals, snacks, training kits, and logistical requirements. 4. The detailed training matrix, including session topics, expected outputs, and assigned learning facilitators, is attached to this memorandum. The activity is expected to cultivate a strong sense of purpose, pedagogy, and professional growth among participants as we take another leap toward meaningful curriculum reform.
5. All attendees are reminded to observe existing health and safety protocols throughout the training.
