(MSM) 2025**

The University of the Philippines Los Baños Mathematical Sciences Society (UPLB MASS), a duly recognized academic organization established in 1973, is conducting its Mathematical Sciences Month 2025 from October 4 to 31, 2025. This year's month-long celebration focuses on the theme "From Equations to Exploration: Mapping the Universe with Mathematical Sciences," highlighting the intersection of Mathematical Sciences and Astronomy. For the past 50 years, UPLB MASS has dedicated itself to promoting deeper appreciation and wider application of mathematical sciences by involving university constituents and the Filipino masses, fostering academic excellence towards social relevance, and contributing to the development of the Filipino nation through mathematical education.

The Mathematical Sciences Month 2025 features three major activities designed to engage secondary school students and educators nationwide. The National Mathematical Challenge (MATHEMATCH) 2025 is a 3-member team quiz competition open to all Junior High School and Senior High School students nationwide, requiring each team to have at least one junior high school student and allowing each participating school to send a maximum of two teams. STAT the Fact 2025 is an online infographic making competition that challenges participants to create compelling visual representations based on this year's National Statistics Month theme, open to all Junior High School and Senior High School students nationwide with each participating school represented by a maximum of 2 registered students.
