- 1. Pursuant to the DepEd Order No. 41, series of 2017, stated that Arabic Emergent Reading and Culture Awareness (AERCA) is a capacity building program for Madrasah Education Program (MEP) implementers to acquire basic knowledge on Arabic Language and Culture that are essential to instructional supervision as well as in the promotion of respect and understanding of Muslim culture, hence, this Office shall conduct Division Strengthening of Arabic Emergent Reading and Culture Awareness (AERCA) for Madrasah Education Program for MEP implementing school heads, focal persons, and teachers on August 28-30, 2025 at the Galilee Wonderland Waterpark & Hotel, Bustos, Bulacan.
- 2. The activity aims for the participants to:
