DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 393, s. 2025

RESEARCH CARAVAN v. 3.0: Advancing Research Excellence through Sustainable Support Systems

To: Division Chiefs

Education Program Supervisors and Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary and Secondary School Heads

All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017, entitled Research Management Guidelines, which emphasizes the provision of technical assistance throughout the research management cycle, the Schools Division Office of Bulacan, through the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC), and the Planning and Research Unit under the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), in coordination with the Public Schools District Supervisors shall conduct the RESEARCH CARAVAN v. 3.0: Advancing Research Excellence through Sustainable Support Systems. This initiative aims to build on the gains of previous iterations by expanding technical assistance through both centralized and decentralized approaches to reach more schools and researchers across the division.
- 2. The implementation of Research Caravan v. 3.0 is anchored on the **SalikSikhay Gabay Project**, which delivers comprehensive technical assistance to researchers at all phases of their research journey. The caravan consists of four (4) phases:
 - Phase 1 SALIKSIKalakbay (August–September 2025): Centralized and decentralized technical assistance sessions for research proposal development Phase 2 Virtual Anchoring (November 2025): Remote TA for research implementation
 - Phase 3 Sharpening the Edge (March 2026): Technical assistance for output finalization

Phase 4 - Bridging Evidence and Impact (April 2026): Technical assistance for research utilization and dissemination.

- 3. Specifically, the activity aims to:
 - 3.1. Sustain the promotion of a culture of research quality, integrity, and collaboration across DepEd Bulacan;
 - 3.2. Provide expanded and adaptive technical assistance to research proposers from each district, from proposal development to output completion;
 - 3.3. Empower research-independent districts to lead localized implementation of technical assistance activities in coordination with their assigned research mentors; and
 - 3.4. Strengthen inter-district collaboration and mentorship between research mentors/coaches and research proposers.
- 4. The target participants of this activity are the members of the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC) and its secretariat, Public Schools District Supervisors, District Research Advisers and Coordinators, District Research Mentors from six (6) EDDISes, and research proposers from each school (at least one per school).
- 5. Implementation shall be in two tracks:

Centralized Track – Face-to-face caravan sessions clustered by EDDIS, led by the SDRC

Decentralized Track – District-managed SALIKSIKalakbay sessions by research-independent districts (Sta. Maria East, Sta. Maria West, Pulilan, Balagtas, Bocaue, Bulakan, Guiguinto, Norzagaray East)

- 6. Participants from schools must be officially identified and endorsed by their respective districts. Districts are encouraged to prioritize schools that have not participated in research activities in the last two school years. Research mentors shall be assigned a maximum of two research proposers per SALIKSIKalakbay session they attend.
- 7. In adherence to DepEd Order No. 9 s. 2005: Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. School heads, research proposers, and research mentors with teaching loads are expected to assign other teachers as substitutes to handle the classes/subjects of the participants. The list of research mentors can be found in enclosure no. 1 of this memorandum.
- 8. Identification of research proposers per district and the process flow of the conduct of the caravan, SALIKSIKalakbay, from pre-activity until post-activity is discussed in enclosure 2 of this memorandum.

- 9. A virtual **SalisiKwentuhan** with the Public Schools District Supervisors, EDDIS Chairpersons of Secondary Schools, Education Program Supervisors, and District Research Advisers shall be conducted on **August 14, 2025, at 1:30 PM via MS Teams** to discuss the schedules of Phase 1 SALIKSIKalakbay for both centralized and decentralized tracks, as well as the preparatory activities before the actual conduct of SALIKSIKalakbay. Once the SALIKSIKalakbay schedules are finalized, a division letter announcing the said schedules shall be issued.
- 10. An online meeting of Division Research Mentors shall be conducted on August 13, 2025, at 1:30 PM via MS Teams in preparation for Phase 1 of the Caravan. This will also serve as an onboarding session for newly designated mentors.
- 11. The expenses to be incurred in the conduct of both centralized and decentralized tracks, particularly for meals (AM snack, lunch, PM snack) of the project management team, research mentors/coaches, and local logistics, shall be charged against the District Local School Board (LSB) Fund or District Local Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel expenses of participants shall likewise be charged against the same local funds.
- 12. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of all participants.
- 13. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.

PROGRAM FLOW for Phase 1 of the RESEARCH CARAVAN v. 3.0: SALIKSIKalakbay

Pre-Coaching (in coordination with PSDSs, District Research Advisers and Coordinators, online modality)

1. Identification of Research Proposers

- Each school shall identify at most two research proposers to receive technical assistance during the SALIKSIKalakbay.
- Districts must prioritize schools that have not conducted research in the last two school years.

2. Submission of List of Proposers

 Districts shall submit the consolidated list of identified research proposers to the Planning and Research Unit, one week before their scheduled SALIKSIKalakbay session.

3. Proposal Preparation

- Identified research proposers shall begin drafting their research proposals.
- Proposers of the committed research shall have their prepared draft proposals. They should be ready with their baseline data, proposed intervention/innovation/strategy, and possible research instruments.

4. Submission of Draft Proposals

 Soft copies of the draft research proposals must be submitted to the Research Caravan Secretariat, one week before the scheduled SALIKSIKalakbay session.

5. Assignment of Research Mentors/Coaches

- The SDRC shall assign a research mentor or coach to each proposer.
- Each mentor/coach will handle a maximum of two research proposers per SALIKSIKalakbay session

6. Initial Review of Proposals

 Assigned mentors/coaches shall conduct an initial reading of the submitted drafts.

7. Preparation of Initial Feedback

• Mentors/coaches shall prepare their initial observations using the revised Technical Assistance (TA) form.

Coaching Day (per District)*

1. Opening Program

Formal opening hosted by the identified district or school.

2. Rapport-Building Session

• Interaction between research mentors/coaches and their assigned research proposers to establish a positive working relationship.

3. **Breakout Coaching Sessions** (by assigned mentor/coach and proposers)

- Discussion of the mentor's initial findings and feedback on the draft research proposal.
- Provision of technical assistance in revising and improving the proposal.
- Signing of the revised TA form and mentoring agreement.

4. Finalization of Research Proposals

 Proposers finalize their research proposals with guidance from their mentors.

5. Printing of Final Proposals

Final copies of the approved research proposals are printed.

6. Synthesis of the Coaching Activity

 Sharing of key insights, learnings, and feedback from both mentors and proposers.

7. Discussion of Ways Forward

 Agreement on next steps, including timelines for proposal submission, implementation, or further mentoring sessions.

*The research proposers during this day should bring their laptop, a copy of their proposal (hardcopy and softcopy), files of baseline data and references, a copy of the curriculum guide (for topics that are learning-area specific), and other materials that may be needed.

*There should be available printers, bond paper, and internet connectivity in the venue of the SALIKSIKalakbay per district.

Post-activity

- District Research Advisers and Coordinators shall facilitate the creation of a directory of the researchers and assigned research mentors.
- A group chat of the researchers and mentors/coaches shall also be created for monitoring and preparation for the activity's second phase.
