


#### NATIONAL BUDGET CIRCULAR

**No.** 596

January 20, 2025

TO

All Heads of Departments, Bureaus, Offices, and Agencies of the National Government, Including State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), and Commissions and Offices under the Constitutional Fiscal Autonomy Group; Government—Owned Or —Controlled Corporations (GOCCs); Local Government Units (LGUs); And All Others Concerned

SUBJECT :

Updated Guidelines on Participation of Government Officials and Employees in Conventions, Seminars, Conferences, Symposia, and Similar Non-Training Gatherings Sponsored by Non-Government Organizations or Private Institutions

#### 1.0 Purpose

This Circular is issued to update the guidelines and the allowable cost of participation of government officials and employees in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia, and other similar gatherings prescribed in National Budget Circular (NBC) No. 563 dated April 22, 2016.

### 2.0 Coverage

- 2.1 This Circular shall cover all activities requiring the payment of registration and related fees for the participation of government personnel in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia, and other similar gatherings conducted/sponsored by non-government organizations or private institutions in the Philippines.
- For purposes of this Circular, conventions, seminars, and the like shall refer to those conducted primarily to share, discuss, or disseminate ideas or information on developments in a particular field or fields of interest for common appreciation, awareness, and resolution of specific issues, as well as to foster collaboration with different stakeholders.

These include, but are not limited to, those conducted by professional

2.3 The Circular excludes those conducted for training purposes where participants are expected to gain or strengthen skills and technical or management expertise relevant to the performance of their official duties and responsibilities.

Therefore, seminars and trainings designed to enhance the participants' abilities/skills in their field or discipline are not covered by this Circular.

#### 3.0 Guidelines

- 3.1 Government officials and employees may be authorized to participate in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia, and such other activities conducted by non-government organizations or private institutions for a fee, as part of the human resource development program of the government, chargeable against agency funds.
- 3.2 The registration or participation fee for said convention, conference, seminar, and symposia, etc. shall not exceed \$2,800 per day per participant.
- For out-of-town conventions, the authorized participants may be entitled to daily travel expenses, subject to the rules and regulations under Executive Order No. 77, s. 2019<sup>1</sup>, and any subsequent rules and regulations governing official travels of government personnel.
- 3.4 Membership and similar fees paid for personal or individual membership in a private organization shall be for the account of the member concerned and shall not be charged to agency funds.
  - On the other hand, institutional membership fees, i.e., agency membership, may be charged against the respective agency funds.
- 3.5 As far as practicable, government personnel should take advantage of the early registration rates to lower the cost of participating in conventions, seminars, conferences, and the like.
- 3.6 All expenditures for the purpose shall be subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

# 4.0 Applicability to Commissions and Offices under the Constitutional Fiscal Autonomy Group and GOCCs covered by Republic Act (RA) No. 10149<sup>2</sup>

The Commissions and Offices enjoying fiscal autonomy are enjoined to adopt the provisions of this Circular. Meanwhile, the GOCCs covered under RA No. 10149 shall be guided by the relevant issuances of the Governance Commission for GOCCs.

## 5.0 Responsibility of Agency Heads

Agency Heads shall be responsible for the implementation of the provisions of this Circular in their respective offices.

The Agency Heads shall be responsible for determining the training needs of their respective personnel, as part of the agency's Career and Development Plan<sup>3</sup>, to ensure the development and retention of a competent and efficient workforce in the public service.

# 6.0 Repealing Clause

All other circulars and issuances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with this Circular are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

### 7.0 Effectivity

This Circular shall take effect on January 1, 2025 after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation and after the filing thereof in the Office of the National Administrative Register at the University of the Philippines Law Center.

### **Illustrative Examples**

#### Illustrative Example I

Professional Organization ABC will have a three-day annual convention-seminar in Iloilo City. Registration fee is P2,500 per day, while annual individual membership fee is P500 per person.

Ms. Cha Cristobal, an employee of Agency A that is based in Metro Manila, expressed her interest to join the convention-seminar in order to learn about the latest development and best practices in her field/profession. The attendance in such a convention-seminar is aligned with the Agency A's Career and Development Program.

The errore registration fee for the 3-day seminar amounting to \$7,500 may be charged against the budget of the agency concerned. On the other hand, the individual membership fee shall be shouldered by Ms. Cristobal.

Moreover, since the official travel will be beyond the 50-km radius from her permanent station. Ms. Cristobal may be entitled to (a) transportation and miscellaneous expenses; and (b) crim travel expenses (DTE) of P1,800 per day (*Cluster II*) for hotel/lodging, meals, and moreover expenses, subject to the rules and regulations under EO No. 77, s. 2019, as may be amended.
