DIVISION CAPACITY BUILDING OF ENGLISH AND FILIPINO HEAD TEACHERS/COORDINATORS IN THE SECONDARY LEVEL ON MONITORING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ARAL READING PROGRAM

- 1. By developing a pool of highly trained monitors, this Office seeks to ensure the successful implementation of the ARAL program across all key stages. This initiative aligns with the national goals of learning recovery, literacy improvement, and equitable access to quality education. It also demonstrates a strong commitment to addressing the specific reading challenges revealed by Bulacan's assessment data, aiming to close the literacy gap among Bulakenyo learners. The Office's efforts reinforce the importance of continuous professional development as a means to foster sustainable literacy improvements in SDO Bulacan. Hence, a **Division Capacity Building of English and Filipino Head Teachers/Coordinators in the Secondary Level on Monitoring the Implementation of Aral Reading Program** shall be conducted on September 10, 2025, at Sapientia Ideation Center, Dr. Yanga's Colleges, Bocaue, Bulacan.
- 2. By the end of this Capacity Building, the participants should be able to:
 - Strengthen head teachers/coordinators' understanding of the implementation of the ARAL Reading Program, specifically on teacher-tutors' competencies of foundational reading components such as phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension, for them to conduct monitoring activities effectively; and
 - Develop a comprehensive action plan at the district and school levels to effectively monitor the implementation of the ARAL Reading Program.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the Filipino and English Head Teachers/Coordinators from the secondary schools who will be responsible for providing technical assistance among teacher-tutors and conducting monitoring in the implementation of the ARAL Program..
