ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION  
MID-YEAR REPORT FOR SY 2025-2026

1. The Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program is a national learning intervention initiative by the Department of Education (DepEd), aimed at supporting struggling learners in public elementary and secondary schools. Its key objectives are to provide targeted support for learners performing below minimum proficiency in reading to address learning losses exacerbated by the pandemic, and foster foundational skills for Kindergarten to Grade 10 learners. The key component is Tutoring: One-on-one or small group sessions (1:5 or 1:15 tutor-learner ratio). To ensure that the objectives are carried out, an online meeting shall be conducted on the following schedule provided in the Table below.

  - Understand the conduct of the CHECK-IN Assessment and report properly;
  - Continuous utilization of the ARAL Program Learning Resources across Key Stages from ARAL Basic to ARAL Plus;
  - Report on the Best Practices that make the program effective; and
  - other matters related to the implementation of the program.
