There is an importance of convening in Curriculum Setting. **Collaboration**: Brings together diverse perspectives from educators, and subject matter experts. **Shared Vision**: Helps establish common goals and understanding of curriculum objectives. **Needs Assessment**: Enables discussion on learner needs, societal requirements, and educational priorities. **Expert Input**: Taps into specialized knowledge for curriculum design and content validation. **Stakeholder Buy-in**: Involves key stakeholders, fostering ownership and support for curriculum initiatives. **Problem-Solving**: Facilitates dialogue to address challenges in curriculum implementation. These are the aspects of the importance of convening. To realize this, the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct the **First Quarter Meeting of Education Program Supervisors and Public Schools District Supervisors on the Strategies, Methodologies, and Improvement** on January 26, 2026, 8:00 AM at Guiguinto District Hall, Guiguinto, Bulacan.

  - **Enhance Instructional Leadership**: Strengthen supervisors' skills in guiding teachers for improved teaching and learning outcomes.
  - **Align with National Education Goals**: Ensure supervisors understand and support DepEd's strategic priorities like the 5-point agenda.
  - **Improve Monitoring and Evaluation**: Equip supervisors with tools for effective program assessment and feedback mechanisms.
  - **Foster Collaboration and Sharing**: Encourage exchange of best practices among supervisors across divisions.
  - **Address Learning Gaps**: Focus on strategies tackling learning losses, especially post-pandemic challenges like those addressed by the Aral Program.



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- **Professional Development:** Provide updates on DepEd policies, Philippine Professional Standards for Supervisors, and latest educational trends.
- **Support Teacher Welfare:** Discuss initiatives enhancing teacher workload management and compensation.
