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Under the school-based training schemes, financial support is sought from district supervisors and school heads through the Municipal Local School, board/ canteen/ school funds and stakeholders/partners. Also, service credit shall be awarded to all trainers, coaches, and assistant coaches/chaperones of CLRAA 2026-bound athletes from the public schools under SDO Bulacan. The School Sports Coordinator will prepare the **After School Sports Program and Training Matrix** with a cover letter and communication, and, in accordance with the approved CSSP SSC1 and SSC2 forms, submit it to the division office addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent and attention to SGOD-Youth Formation and Sports Development Unit.

A separate memorandum will be issued regarding the information on the conduct of **Hosted Centralized Training-SDO-PGB SEF Funded beginning March 6, 2026**. Schools without players /representatives to the 2026 CLRAA Meet are also requested to provide their share of financial support to their district/EDDIS delegation.

9. Athletes, coaches, chaperones, trainers, and officials must bring their bedding, mess kits, sleeping and playing clothes, rubber shoes, slippers, toiletries, etc. The SDO will provide the sleeping mattress.

10. Student-athletes of each delegation representing their EDDIS bound to CLRAA 2026 shall automatically divert to Alternative Delivery Modality (ADM) through Modular and Online Learning Modes provided that their subject teachers shall consider the activity requirements to be completed and submitted by the student-athletes since they are engaged in the intensive training and the CLRAA 2026 proper. School Heads, as the Instructional Leaders of their respective schools, shall orient all the teachers involved in CLRAA 2026 and their respective subject teachers to consider the student-athletes since the division is encouraged to balance academic and co-extra/co-curricular activities as learner support services. Training is designed as a whole-day and D.M. No. 025, s. 2026 is strictly observed.

11. Teachers and Teaching-Related Personnel who will serve as coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, members of the delegations, and technical officials during the intensive training and CLRAA Meet 2026 proper shall be granted service credits pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 on the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teacher while Non-Teaching Personnel/Teaching Related Personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance with Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.



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12. A monitoring team through M & E tool and system shall be organized to oversee the progress of the intensive training from school-based to centralized. An online monitoring and reporting system shall be used to analyze the progress of our athletes and the training program.

13. Proper decorum must be observed by all officials, coaches, chaperones, and athletes concerned. They are expected to perform their best for the productive participation of Team Bulacan in this regional conclave. A Parent's permit must be secured from all the athletes of Team Bulacan. Athletes, Coaches, Asst. Coaches, Chaperones, and concerned personnel are directed to bring their own utensils and canister/tumblers during the intensive training, as we practice the SDO Bulacan's Green Champions, CLAYGO is initiated in all training venues and at all times.

14. Coaches from private schools are requested to coordinate closely with DepEd Bulacan SGOD Supervisor & Division Sports Officer (Jay-Arr C. Tayao, DBA, EdD)/ PDO I Youth Formation and Sports Development Unit (Redhen Jade M. Velasquez) at sgodbulacan@deped.gov.ph.

15. All expenses to be incurred relative to the conduct of this activity, like school-based and subsidized training, which shall be taken from the support given by Municipal LSB-SEF/schools canteen and local funds/MOOE/other sources and PGB-SEF-funded training shall be charged from the 2026 Provincial Special Education Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

16. All concerned are reminded to adhere strictly to the health and safety protocols and to observe proper nutrition standards as set by the SGOD-SHNU.

17. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of all concerned.

18. Strict compliance with the foregoing instructions is enjoined.

19. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
