
1. This Office hereby announces the conduct of the Development of the Test Items for the implementation of Project A.S.A.L. (Assessment Standards for Affective Learning), a division-led capacity-building and quality assurance initiative aimed at strengthening classroom assessment practices in GMRC and Values Education, aligned with the enhanced K to 12 Curriculum and DepEd Order No. 8, s. 2015. The activity shall be conducted for two (2) days on January 16 and 22, 2026, with a week-long write-shop in between, at Lagundi Elementary School, Plaridel District. Participants include elementary and secondary school principals, master teachers, teachers, Values Education head teachers, and resource persons, with a total of 35 participants.
2. The project seeks to address gaps in assessing affective learning outcomes by equipping school leaders and teachers with valid, reliable, and context-appropriate formative assessment tools for values formation, character development, and behavior change. It also aims to standardize assessment practices and develop a division-level repository of validated tools.
3. The activity is anchored on the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) Domains 1, 2, 4, and 7, and supports the DepEd 5-Point Reform Agenda, particularly on teacher quality and modernized assessment practices.
4. The Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), through the EPS in GMRC and Values Education, shall manage the implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of the project, in coordination with the Division Training Team and

LRMDS. Expenses shall be charged against the Division MOOE Fund, while transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the school local fund, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. This Office reiterates the implementation of DepEd Order No.9, s. 2005 titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith." Classes must remain uninterrupted, and concerned school heads are reminded that substitute teachers must be assigned to those teachers who will attend this capacity building.
6. All concerned are enjoined to extend full support and cooperation to ensure the successful implementation of this activity.
7. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority for all participants.
8. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
