ORGANIZATION OF DEPED BULACAN WIND/JAZZ BAND

1. This is to announce that this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), shall organize DepEd Bulacan Wind/Jazz band.
2. The objectives of organizing the said group are as follows:
 - a. to assist the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) Implementing Schools in their instrumental classes by giving lectures via concert presentation;
 - b. to assist Senior High School Arts and Design Track Implementers;
 - c. to provide opportunities to DepEd employees and teachers with varied activities that will enhance their knowledge and skills in playing musical instruments;
 - d. to serve as an avenue for benchmarking to other schools offering SPA instrumental classes; and
 - e. to participate in the different programs and activities of DepEd that require the service of the Wind/Jazz Band.
3. The incoming members of this group shall be chosen based on the level of capability in playing a certain musical instrument. Levels 2 and 3 instrumental players shall be given priority to become initial members of the group.
4. Enclosure 1 is the List of DepEd Employees that shall undergo audition to be a member of DepEd Bulacan Wind/Jazz Band. Immediate superiors of those who are included in the list are requested to allow them to participate in the process to become regular members of the band.
5. In compliance with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 2005 titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance

Therewith." Classes must remain uninterrupted, and concerned school heads are reminded that substitute teachers must be assigned to those teachers who will join this activity.

6. Audition and first rehearsal of the group shall be on **February 13, 2026**, from **8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m. at Pulilan Central School, Pulilan, Bulacan**. The attendance of the members shall be on official business.
7. Participants are advised to bring their instruments.
8. Meals and snacks for the above-mentioned activities shall be charged against Division Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) while transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against school MOOE or other local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. This Memorandum serves as the **Travel Authority** for all the participants.
10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
