**IMPLEMENTATION OF PROJECT VALENTINES DAY:
TEACHERS AND PRINCIPALS MAKEOVER**

1. In reference to unnumbered DepEd Central Office Memorandum and Regional Office Memorandum No. 15, s. 2026 entitled "**Project Valentine's Day: Teachers and Principals Makeover,**" and in line with the Department of Education's commitment to promoting the well-being, morale, and holistic development of teachers and school heads, this Office hereby implements the aforesaid program in the Schools Division of Bulacan on February 14, 2026 (Saturday) starting at 8AM at the Guiguinto Municipal Athletic & Cultural Center (GMACC).
2. This activity aims to recognize and appreciate the dedication, hard work, and commitment of teachers and school heads by providing them with a lighthearted pampering and wellness experience on Valentine's Day.
3. The following services shall be offered to select teachers and principals by the Schools Division of Bulacan, in partnership with Guiguinto National Vocational High School (GNVHS), Assemblywoman Felicita G. Bernardino Memorial Trade School, TESDA – Guiguinto, Haring Ibon Foundation, and BDO Unibank. Teachers and personnel designated as members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) and those who will render services for the participants shall be granted appropriate service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024.:
 - a. **Hairdressing Services**
 - a.1 Hair Color with Hair Cut (Pre-shampooing is required)
 - a.2 Brazilian Treatment with Hair Cut (Pre-shampooing is required)
 - a.3 Hair Cut with Head Massage and Styling
 - b. **Beauty Care Services**
 - b.1 Hand Spa (Paraffin Wax Treatment) with Manicure
 - b.2 Nail Extension (Soft Gel) with Manicure
 - b.3 Basic Facial Treatment with 5-in-1 Facial Machine
 - b.4 Eyelash Extension and Brow Services (Classic Full or Clustered Lash)
 - b.5 Head and Back Massage
4. To ensure quality service delivery and proper crowd management, only around 30–35 participants per time slot, with a total of only 100 slots for all services combined shall be accommodated. Each participant shall be allowed to avail of only one (1) preferred service to provide equitable opportunity for others to benefit from the activity.



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5. The division of participants into time slots is necessary to prevent overcrowding, ensure orderly movement, and allow service providers to deliver focused, hygienic, and high-quality services to each participant without compromising comfort and safety.
6. All interested participants are required to register through this official online registration form: **<https://forms.gle/JvzQ8UNrim4yabw36>** on a first-come, first-served basis. The online form shall serve as the official mechanism for identifying participants, determining preferred services, and assigning time slots, thereby ensuring proper scheduling, efficient workflow, and smooth implementation of the activity.
7. All participants are expected to observe proper decorum and comply with health and safety protocols during the activity.
8. Program Support Funds shall be downloaded to cover meals and other incidental expenses relative to the implementation of this activity.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is directed for the information, guidance, and compliance of all concerned.

In celebration of Valentine's Day and in recognition of the invaluable service and dedication of our public-school teachers and principals, the Department of Education (DepEd), in partnership with the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and other stakeholders, will implement the **Project: Valentine's Day Teachers and Principals Makeover**.

This project aims to provide a special pampering and makeover experience for our principals and teachers, which includes the provision of makeup kits and services such as hairdressing, makeup, manicure and pedicure, facial, massage, and other wellness services.

The activity is targeted to be conducted on **February 14, 2026 (Saturday)**, with **100 teachers and principals per region**, or a total of **1,700 beneficiaries nationwide**. Venues shall be determined by the respective regional offices (ROs).
