1. In accordance with the mandates and provisions outlined in DepEd Memorandum No. 021, s. 2026, regarding the national contests in campus journalism, this Office hereby releases the official delegation representing the Schools Division Office of Bulacan for the 2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), scheduled on April 13-17, 2026, in Ormoc City, Leyte.
2. Enclosure No. 1 contains the Official List of the SDO Bulacan Delegation for the 2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC). The official list includes teacher-coaches, learners, and all other concerned individuals who have essential and indispensable tasks in monitoring and supervising the conduct of all events and contests, providing technical assistance, and conducting final simulation sessions for the national qualifiers.
3. Additionally, service credits or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) shall be granted to the participants and personnel for activities that fall during the End-Of-School-Year (EOSY) break, vacation, weekend, or holiday. This is in accordance with DepEd Order Nos. 013 s. 2024 and 53, s. 2003, DBM-CSC Joint Circular No. 002, s. 2015, and DepEd Memoranda Nos. 65 & 67, s. 2021.
4. Also, school heads must ensure that the concerned teacher-coaches have selected the aforementioned contest dates as their reporting to duty period, following the essential guidelines and provisions outlined in DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2025 and DM-OSEC-OUHROD-OPS-2025-001 pertaining to the 30-day uninterrupted vacation for teachers, allowing them to choose their vacation period either continuously or on a staggered basis, depending on summer program/activity schedules.
5. As stated in DepEd Memorandum No. 021 s. 2026, travel and incidental expenses including board and lodging, meals, transportation rental, supplies and materials, and other related expenses for the participants and the delegation team shall be covered by any of the following such as Central and Regional Office funds, Division

and School MOOE/Local School Board (LSB) Funds, Special Education funds, Campus Journalism funds, or any available provincial, municipal, or school local funds as applicable. All these pertinent expenses of the participants involved in the activity are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Elementary and secondary schools with NSPC qualifiers must secure parental consent for their learners' participation in the aforementioned national activities.
7. All provisions outlined in the recently released DepEd Memorandum No. 021 s. 2026 must be strictly observed. Proper coordination with the head of the delegation team and assigned monitors and trainers is essential to ensure that NSPC activities are consistently adhered to before, during, and after the contests.
8. This Memorandum serves as the travel authority of the participants involved in the activity.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
