1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 096, s. 2026 titled "Conduct of Year-End School-Based Management (SBM) Self-Assessment and Consolidated Status Reporting," and in compliance with DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2024, this Office directs all public elementary and secondary schools to conduct a comprehensive SBM Self-Assessment for the end of the current school year.
2. This activity is anchored on the following objectives:
 - assess SBM practices in all schools;
 - identify strengths and gaps to determine where technical assistance is needed;
 - use data for better division planning and support;
 - promote continuous improvement in school governance and student results;
 - gather data to help with national policy, funding, and planning; and
 - ensure transparency and accountability through proper documentation and monitoring
3. All School Heads are directed to accomplish the reporting requirements via the official MS Form link, <https://tinyurl.com/SBMBulacan2026>, no later than **April 17, 2026**.
4. The online report must accurately highlight the following components:
 - Current SBM Level;
 - Notable Strengths and Best Practices;
 - Areas for Improvement;
 - Priority Interventions; and
