**IMPLEMENTATION OF HEALTH STATUS REPORTING SYSTEM FOR
LEARNERS AND PERSONNEL**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
Division and District Supervisors
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
All others Concerned

1. The Schools Division Office, through the School Health and Nutrition Unit, announces the implementation of the Health Status Reporting Form for both learners and personnel. This initiative aims to standardize the submission and consolidation of health-related reports from all schools to the division health unit. This form is intended for learners and personnel who wish to consult *non-urgent* medical concerns such as cough, colds, mild fever, and other similar conditions. This form is open to everyone and may be accomplished on a regular or as needed basis to ensure timely guidance and appropriate health monitoring.
2. The **Health Status Reporting Form** is designed to:
 1. provide a uniform mechanism for reporting non-urgent health concerns;
 2. ensure timely and accurate monitoring of health trends within schools;
 3. support the health unit in evidence-based planning and program implementation;
 4. make healthcare more accessible by providing a convenient channel for reporting concerns; and



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5. promote health-seeking behavior among teaching and non-teaching personnel by encouraging early reporting and consultation.
3. The form shall be used **strictly for non-urgent or non-emergency health concerns.**
 1. for **urgent, emergency, or potentially life-threatening situations**, learners and personnel must be **immediately referred to the nearest Emergency Room or healthcare facility.**

5. This form shall be disseminated to all schools through official communication channels. School Heads are directed to:
 - a. ensure that teachers, designated health focal persons, and relevant staff are familiar with the process;



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- b. encourage all personnel and learners (through parents/guardians) to use the form when appropriate;
 - c. coordinate with the School Health and Nutrition Unit for any clarifications.
6. All submitted reports will be treated with utmost confidentiality in accordance with DepEd policies on data privacy and health information management.
