2. Specifically, the activity aims to discuss the following:
 - 2.1. Disseminate important policies, guidelines, and updates relative to the opening of classes as stipulated on DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 titled, *Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education*,
 - 2.2. Ensure compliance with minimum standards for school operation, health and safety protocols,
 - 2.3. Provide guidance on Strengthened Senior High School curriculum implementation, and
 - 2.4. Address concerns and clarifications from private school stakeholders.
3. Participants in this MANCOM meeting are the school heads of all private schools from kindergarten, elementary, junior and senior high school levels.
