**DIVISION IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 2026 SUMMER  
REMEDiation PROGRAMS**

1. Anent to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2026 titled Guidelines for the Implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Programs, this Office shall implement the Summer Remediation Programs as follows:

<b>Summer Remediation Program</b>	<b>Grade Level</b>
ARAL Summer-Reading	Incoming Grade 2 to Incoming Grade 11
ARAL Summer-Mathematics	Incoming Grade 2,3, and 4
Senior High School Remediation-English	Incoming Grade 12
Senior High School Remediation-Mathematics	Incoming Grade 12
Summer Academic Remedial Program	All grade level

**2. Summer Remediation Programs**

The Summer Remediation Programs shall be conducted during the break between school years. The school where the learner completed the previous grade level is responsible for providing these programs to students identified as needing targeted support based on the final grades or EOSY assessment results. This year, the SRP shall be implemented from **May 6 to June 2, 2026**.

- **ARAL Summer-Reading**

A 20-day tutorial program that aims to enable struggling readers to achieve grade-level proficiency through effective, research-based, and differentiated instruction, improved assessment practices, and access to print or digital reading materials. It shall cover incoming grades 2,3, and 4 learners at the Emerging levels, and incoming grades 5 to 11 learners at the Frustration level in English.

- **ARAL Summer-Mathematics**

A 20-day tutorial program designed to strengthen foundational mathematics skills through targeted instruction and structured practice that address identified learning gaps and support the attainment of grade-level proficiency. The program shall cover Grades 2, 3, and 4 learners who are Not Proficient and Low Proficient levels.

- **Senior High School Remediation Program**

This program is a 20-day program that aims to strengthen learners' foundational skills in English and Mathematics through targeted instruction, focused practice, and appropriate learning support to enable them to meet the demands of H}SHS. This program shall cover incoming grade 12 learners who are at the Frustration Level in English or at the Not Proficient or Low Proficient levels in Mathematics.

- **Summer Academic Remedial Program**

This is to ensure that learners acquire the necessary competencies to progress to the next grade level. This program shall cover public and private elementary and secondary school learners in Key Stages 1 to 4 who failed one or two subjects in SY 2025-2026. Learners participating in this program shall be assessed according to the provisions of DepEd Memorandum No. 35, s. 2025 titled Supplemental Guidelines for the Implementation of the Summer Academic Remedial Program.

**3. Structure of Summer Remediation Program Sessions**

This program shall be conducted from Monday to Friday, with Fridays designated for home-based learning for learners and for teachers' preparation of instructional materials and documentation of learner progress. On home-based learning days, teachers shall provide minimal supervision while guiding learners in the completion of assigned remote tasks.

A maximum tutor-to-learner ratio of 1:10 to ensure focused and effective instruction. Learners may be grouped according to proficiency levels; however, in cases where mixed-ability groups are necessary, tutors shall employ differentiated instructional strategies to address the diverse learning needs of teachers.

• **Duration of SRP sessions:**

<b>Summer Remediation Program</b>	<b>Number of Hours per learning area per day (with 30 minutes break)</b>
<b>ARAL Summer Program</b> Reading/Mathematics	2 hours
<b>Senior High School Remediation Program</b> English/Mathematics	2 hours
<b>Summer Academic Remedial Program</b> All learning areas	2 hours
<b>Summer Academic Remedial Program</b> Senior High School	2 hours

4. Learners who will be participating in the TARA BASA! Tutoring Program of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) need not participate in the ARAL Summer-Reading Program.
5. The SRP may be implemented through face-to-face, online, or blended learning modalities, depending on the school context, learner needs, and available resources.
6. Schools shall engage DepEd teachers and external tutors in the implementation of the ARAL Summer Programs and the SHS Remediation Program. The engagement of DepEd teachers and external tutors as ARAL tutors shall be governed by DepEd Memorandum No. 1, s. 2026 titled Guidelines in the engagement of Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Tutors and Support Aides.
7. Public school teachers who attend training related to SRP or handle tutorial sessions totaling six (6) hours of actual service shall earn one (1) day of vacation service credit. The following incentives are available to SRP teachers, subject to government rules and regulations:
  - Vacation Service Credits
  - Certificate of Appreciation for Teachers or Volunteers
  - Other incentives subject to the availability of funds and applicable guidelines
