**CONDUCT OF THE YEAR-END EVALUATION OF THE PROGRAMS,
PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES IN SCIENCE FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025–2026**

1. The Schools Division of Bulacan announces the conduct of the Year-End Evaluation of the Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) of the Regular and Special Science Curriculum for School Year 2025–2026, scheduled on **Friday, 22 May 2026** at **Virginia Ramirez-Cruz National High School, Pandi, Bulacan**.
2. In alignment with the Department of Education's efforts to strengthen curriculum implementation, instructional supervision, and governance, this activity aims to evaluate the implementation status of Science PPAs in the elementary and secondary levels, including the Regular Science Program, Special Science Elementary Schools (SSES), and Science, Technology, and Engineering (STE). The evaluation shall focus on teaching performance, learning outcomes, and implementation practices to inform division improvement strategies.
3. Specifically, the activity seeks to: review year-end accomplishments and academic performance in Science; identify issues and concerns encountered during implementation; and guide participants in the preparation of school and district-based Science action plans aligned with division priorities for the incoming school year.
4. Participants to the activity include District Science Advisers, SSES Coordinators, Head Teachers of STE Implementers, Secondary Head Teachers/Subject Coordinators, and members of the Technical Working Group. They are required to register online at **bit.ly/2026-YearEnd** on or before **May 19, 2026**.
5. Meal expenses of participants shall be charged against the Division MOOE fund while transportation and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants in attendance of the said training shall be charged to local or school/MOOE fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.



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6. Teacher-participants will be given vacation Service Credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024, entitled 'Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Service Credits for Teachers.'
7. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
