DIVISION PREPARATION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR (BOSY) ASSESSMENTS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027

- Anent to DepEd Order No. 9, s. In 2026, titled Guidelines in the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education, this Office directs all schools, both elementary and secondary, to plan and prepare for the administration of the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA), Phil- Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI), and Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) for the Beginning-Of-School-Year (BOSY), SY 2026-2027, for the Opening Block dated June 8 to 11, 2026.
- There will be an online re-orientation on the administration of the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA), Phil-Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI), and Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) on the following schedules:

June 4, 2026 at 1:00PM	Elementary Group

- All school heads are requested to:
 - Prepare for the copies of the Assessment Tools and Teachers' Guides/Manuals (supplied last year) for the administration of the BOSY for the CRLA, PHIL-IRI, and RMA
 - Conduct school-level re-orientation among teachers concerned with the administration of these assessments
 - Conduct orientation among learners and parents on the administration of the BOSY assessments
 - Conduct the BOSY assessments this opening block
 - Monitor the conduct of the BOSY assessments (CRLA, PHIL-IRI, and RMA)
