1. Attached is the 1st Endorsement dated June 16, 2026 from the Office of the Regional Director, DepEd Regional Office III, relative to the request of the Action and Solidarity for the Empowerment of Teachers – Central Luzon Union (ASSERT-CLU) regarding the conduct of its **Division-Level Leaders Forum for Bulacan on June 30, 2026, from 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 N.N.**
2. The activity aims to provide updates on union programs and activities, strengthen leadership and organizational structures, discuss the ratification of the Union's Constitution and By-Laws, and gather issues and concerns from union members.
3. In line with the Regional Office endorsement, the communication is hereby disseminated to concerned schools and district offices for information and appropriate action.
4. Participation of identified union officers and members shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Attendance shall be voluntary and shall not be construed as mandatory for any teaching or non-teaching personnel;
 - b. Prior written approval from the concerned School Head shall be secured before participation;
 - c. No classes, learning sessions, school activities, or delivery of basic education services shall be disrupted or adversely affected;
 - d. School Heads shall ensure that appropriate measures are undertaken to prevent loss of instructional time and to maintain uninterrupted school operations;
 - e. This Memorandum shall not be construed as an automatic grant of Official Business status, travel authority, or entitlement to reimbursement of travel and other expenses, unless otherwise authorized in accordance with existing DepEd, Civil Service Commission, DBM, COA, and other applicable rules and regulations; and
 - f. Participants shall remain accountable for compliance with all applicable government rules and policies during the conduct of the activity.
5. School Heads are enjoined to exercise sound discretion in acting upon requests for attendance, taking into consideration the operational requirements of their respective schools and the welfare of learners.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.

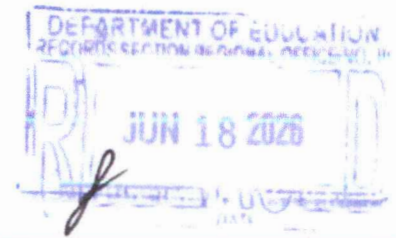
