Relative to the recent incidents of school-related violence involving learners that resulted in the tragic loss of lives, this Office strongly encourages all School Heads to closely coordinate with the Philippine National Police (PNP) through their respective Municipal Police Stations to further strengthen and enhance security measures within school premises.

In particular, schools are advised to intensify the implementation of security protocols at all school entrances and exits, and to provide appropriate capacity-building or coaching activities for school watchmen and security guards to equip them with the necessary skills and knowledge in effectively managing security-related incidents and emergency situations.

The following shall be available in school in times of monitoring:

- Core plans and Policies School safety and Security Plan (updated), DRRM Plan, DRRM Contingency Plan, Child Protection Policy (CPP) Implementation Plan, Crisis Management Plan.
- Coordination evidence: Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Memorandum of Understanding with the Philippine National Police or Barangay, Communication logs and records of coordination activities Patrol schedules and /or formal request letters for security assistance.
- Monitoring and Records Visitors logbooks, incident reports covering the past 6-12 months, Security audit checklist and corresponding result, Gate entry and exit monitoring system (manual or digital)

Let us remain vigilant and proactive in safeguarding our learners. Together, we can ensure that our schools continue to be among the safest places in our communities, fostering an environment conducive to learning, growth, and well-being.
