

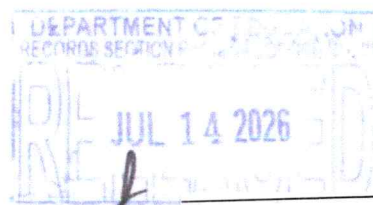

This is also subject to the no-collection policy under Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, also known as the Ganzon Law.

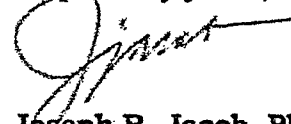

SEPTEMBER 30, 2026

Deadline for Submission of Research Proposals

Last day to submit research proposals for screening and evaluation.

OCTOBER 20, 2026

Release of Proposal Evaluation Results

Schools will receive notification of approved research proposals qualified for the National Science and Engineering Fair.

OCTOBER 21, 2026

Official Registration Opens

Qualified schools may officially register their approved entries.
