Please be informed that the Division Sports Clinic and Accreditation Course for Teacher-Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Chaperones, and Teacher Officiating Officials, in preparation for PAM, CLRAA, and Palarong Pambansa 2027, initiated by BSSA, Inc., originally scheduled for **September 2-6, 2026**, per D.M. 324, s. 2026, will be **rescheduled to December 7-11, 2026**, due to multiple class suspensions caused by inclement weather conditions, limited preparation, and other school-related activities.

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2025, and in line with our Division's unwavering commitment to promoting the holistic development of learners through physical fitness, sportsmanship, healthy lifestyles, and the sustained advancement of Physical Education, this Office announces the Schedule and Calendar of Activities for the Comprehensive School Sports Program (CSSP) for School Year 2026-2027.

This initiative is anchored on the three (3) flagship components of the CSSP:

1.1 Sports Education and Standards – through the implementation of the After-School Sports Program;

1.2 Sports as a Learner Support Program – through the Enhancement and Distribution of Sports Supplies and Equipment;

1.3 Sports Competitions – including School Intramurals, Sports Club Competitions, and participation in Provincial, Regional, and National Meets.

2. These programs aim to foster a culture of excellence, inclusivity, and active participation in sports, aligned with our goal of nurturing well-rounded, resilient, and physically active learners.

3. For this S.Y. 2026-2027, the official Cut-Off Year of the age requirements and eligibility of athletes is as follows:

- Elementary: Born on January 1, 2014 onwards
- Secondary: Born on January 1, 2009 onwards

4. For more information and guidance, please revisit DepEd Memo No. 033, s. 2026 titled: Conduct of Palarong Pambansa 2026, or you may contact Jay-Arr C. Tayao, DBA, EdD, Education Program Supervisor-SGOD/Division Sports Officer at jayarr.tayao@deped.gov.ph/official sports GCs of SDO Bulacan.

5. Expenses incurred during the conduct of the listed activities, such as meals/training expenses and other allowable expenses, shall be charged against the respective municipal SEF, BSSA Funds, Local/School Funds, and Provincial SEF. Transportation



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expenses shall be charged against the school's local fund and are subject to the accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

6. Republic Act No. 10676, also known as the *Student-Athletes Protection Act*, and its *Implementing Rules and Regulations (2021)* mandate that schools safeguard the academic welfare of student-athletes while promoting their holistic development. Participation in sports competitions such as the *Palarong Pambansa* and regional meets often requires extended absences from class, which may affect academic performance. This memorandum provides institutional guidelines to ensure compliance with RA 10676 and DepEd policies. In compliance with Republic Act No. 10676 – Student-Athletes Protection Act (2015), *Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 10676 (Student-Athletes Protection Act, 2021)*, which directly addresses the balance between academics and athletics.

Policy Guidelines

A. Academic Protection

- Student-athletes must be provided with **flexible learning modalities** (online platforms, modular lessons, recorded lectures).
- Teachers shall administer **special examinations or alternative assessments** for athletes who miss scheduled tests due to competitions.
- Schools must establish **tutorial/remedial programs** to address learning gaps.

B. Coordination and Monitoring

- **Advisers and coaches** shall coordinate training schedules with academic requirements to minimize disruption.
- A **Student-Athlete Support Desk** shall be created to monitor grades, attendance, and athletic performance.
- Parents shall be regularly informed of both academic and athletic standing.

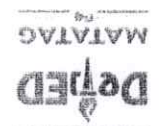
C. Rights and Welfare

- Student-athletes are entitled to **balanced development** (academic, athletic, social, emotional).
- Schools must provide access to **counseling and mental health services**.
- Scholarships and benefits must be **transparent and aligned with RA 10676 IRR**.

D. Prohibition of Exploitation

- Schools and associations are prohibited from **commercializing or exploiting student-athletes**.
- Recruitment practices must be ethical and compliant with DepEd rules, issuances, and policies.
- Violations shall be subject to sanctions as prescribed in the IRR.

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Implementation

- All faculty members shall integrate these guidelines into their academic planning.
- Coaches and advisers must submit **monthly reports** on student-athlete academic progress.
- School heads shall ensure strict compliance and report implementation status to the Division Office.

Student-athletes of each delegation representing their EDDIS bound to PAM 2027 shall strictly observe the AFTER-SCHOOL SPORTS PROGRAM TRAININGS in compliance with instructional block in the school calendar and the **DM NO. 25, s.2026: REITERATION ON PARTICIPATION OF LEARNERS IN THE CO-CURRICULAR, AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS**, while for CLRAA 2027, and PP2027 shall automatically divert to Alternative Delivery Modality (ADM) through Modular or Online Learning Modes provided that their subject teachers shall consider the activity requirements to be completed and submitted by the student-athletes since they are engaged in the intensive training thru CSSPs SSC After School Sports Program. School Heads, as the Instructional Leaders of their respective schools, shall orient all teachers involved in the Sporting events, as well as their respective subject teachers, to consider student-athletes, since the division is encouraged to balance academic and co-extra/co-curricular activities as learner support services.

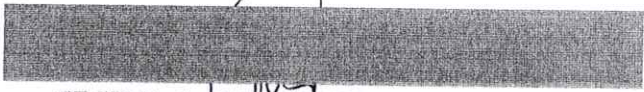
7. Teachers and Teaching-Related Personnel who will serve as coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, members of the delegations, and technical officials, and teacher-trainers during the intensive trainings and PAM 2027, CLRAA 2027, and PP2027 proper shall be granted service credits pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 on the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teacher while Non-Teaching Personnel/Teaching Related Personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance with Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.

6. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of all concerned participants, accompanied by a Locator Slip signed by the School Heads/PSDS/Head of the Agency.

7. Details of each activity shall be announced in a separate memorandum.
