**DIVISION TRAINING ON THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
FINANCIAL EDUCATION AND LITERACY PROGRAM (FELP) FINED COURSE**

1. The DepEd Schools Division Office of Bulacan, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the conduct of the Division Training on the Effective Implementation of the Financial Education and Literacy Program (FELP) FinEd Course on August 4, 2026 at Balai Zoilo Teresita Private Resort and Events Place, Calumpit, Bulacan.
2. In line with Memorandum DM-LS-2025-152, this activity serves as a capacity building initiative for Alternative Learning System (ALS) implementers to support the effective, quality, and standardized implementation of the Functional Education and Literacy Program (FELP) – Financial Education (FinEd) Course. It provides participants with a deeper understanding of the program framework, learning standards, instructional delivery, assessment strategies, and monitoring mechanisms to facilitate the successful integration and implementation of the FinEd Course across all ALS learning centers in the division. 3. This training aims to enable participants to:
 3. 1 Strengthen the knowledge and competencies of ALS implementers on the goals, key components, policies, and implementation guidelines of the Financial Education and Literacy Program (FELP) FinEd to ensure quality program delivery;



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- 3.2 Enhance participants' capacity to integrate Financial Education concepts into ALS instruction through the application of effective teaching strategies, contextualized learning resources, and appropriate assessment practices; and
- 3.3 Develop implementation and action plans that promote collaboration, the adoption of best practices, and the sustainable implementation of the Financial Education and Literacy Program (FELP) FinEd across ALS Community Learning Centers.
4. Expenses for meals, snacks, and other incidental costs related to the conduct of the training shall be charged to ALS Program Support Funds. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to school MOOE, Special Education Funds (SEF), and other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
