**IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BAYANIHAN SA KALUSUGAN PROGRAM (BSK):
PROVISION OF FREE BLOOD AND BONE SCREENING SERVICES FOR
SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE PERSONNEL**

1. In support of the Department of Education's commitment to promoting employee health and wellness, and pursuant to the partnership initiative of UNILAB, Inc. through its Bayanihan sa Kalusugan Program (BSK), this Office announces the conduct of the Provision of Free Blood and Bone Screening Services for Schools Division Office Personnel. The activity is intended to promote preventive healthcare by providing free health screening, medical consultation, health education, and appropriate referrals to participating personnel.
2. The activity shall be conducted on August 10, 2026 (Monday), 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at SDO Bulacan Conference Hall, Provincial Capitol Compound, City of Malolos, Bulacan
3. The two hundred (200) participants who voluntarily pre-registered through the online registration system shall include the following:
 - SDO Top Management, Unit Heads, Personnel, and Staff from the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), and Office of the Schools Division Superintendent (OSDS);
 - Public Elementary School Heads, School-Based Project Development Officers I (PDO I) and other non-teaching personnel assigned to the selected districts of Calumpit North, Calumpit South, Paombong, Plaridel, and Guiguinto;
 - Sixty (60) Public Secondary School Heads;
 - Members of the Technical Working Group (TWG); and
 - Representatives from UNILAB, Inc.
4. The activity shall include the following services, subject to the medical protocols and procedures of UNILAB, Inc.:
 - Bone screening;
 - Nerve Testing;
 - Anemia Screening;
 - Random Blood Sugar Test (*no fasting*);
 - Cholesterol Test
 - Uric Acid Test;



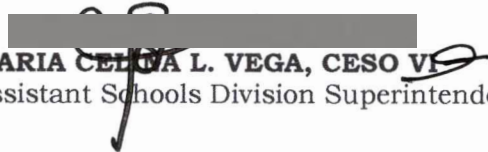
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- Hemoglobin Test;
- Medical consultation;
- Health education;
- Enrollment in the Discount Couponing Program (DCP); and
- Opportunity for access to medicines onsite.

All services shall be provided free of charge and shall not entail any financial obligation on the part of participating personnel.

5. To ensure the orderly conduct of the activity, the following guidelines shall be observed:
 - a. Unit Heads shall ensure the continuous delivery of essential office services.
 - b. Employees shall observe the registration procedures and health protocols prescribed by the organizers.
 - c. The processing of personal and health-related information shall be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012) and other applicable data privacy regulations.
 - d. The activity shall be implemented in close coordination with UNILAB, Inc. and the designated Technical Working Group.
6. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against Division Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), subject to the availability of funds and compliance with existing government budgeting, procurement, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
