**DIVISION ORIENTATION FOR SCHOOL HEADS AND KEY STAKEHOLDERS ON
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM) FOR
EDUCATION IN EMERGENCIES (EiE) IN FLOOD-AFFECTED HIGH- AND
MEDIUM-RISK SCHOOLS**

1. In line with the Department of Education's commitment to ensuring learning continuity, equity, and access to quality education, and consistent with Republic Act No. 10533, otherwise known as the *Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013*, and Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the *Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010*, the implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) serves as a responsive mechanism for addressing learning disruptions brought about by emergencies and disasters. In this context, the DepEd Schools Division Office of Bulacan seeks to promote a coordinated, flexible, and context-responsive approach to education delivery that ensures learners continue to have equitable access to quality and meaningful learning opportunities despite disruptions caused by emergencies and environmental hazards.
2. In this regard, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the conduct of the Division Orientation for School Heads and Key Stakeholders on the Implementation of the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) for Education in Emergencies (EiE) in Flood-Affected High- and Medium-Risk Schools on August 20, 2026 at a venue to be announced.
3. This training aims to enable participants to:
 - 3.1 To guarantee that quality education is sustained despite environmental challenges such as high tide and flooding, through the effective use of ADM;
 - 3.2 To engage parents, LGUs, and stakeholders in supporting ADM initiatives and strengthening disaster-resilient education systems; and
