**RESCHEDULING OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BAYANIHAN SA

1. Relative to Division Memorandum No. 354, s. 2026, titled "*Implementation of the Bayanihan sa Kalusugan Program (BSK): Provision of Free Blood and Bone Screening Services for Schools Division Office Personnel*," this Office announces the **rescheduling of the activity from August 10, 2026 to September 7, 2026 (Monday)**. The activity shall be conducted from **7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the SDO Bulacan Conference Hall, Provincial Capitol Compound, City of Malolos, Bulacan**.
2. The activity originally scheduled on August 10, 2026 did not proceed due to the prevailing adverse weather conditions brought about by the Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) and pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 123, dated August 9, 2026, issued by the Office of the President, which directed the implementation of work-from-home arrangements in government offices in Bulacan and other identified areas on August 10, 2026, in anticipation of continued heavy rainfall.
3. The rescheduling is made in coordination with UNILAB, Inc. to ensure the safe, orderly, and effective implementation of the BSK Program and to enable the pre-registered participants to avail themselves of the free preventive health screening and related services originally provided under previously issued Memorandum.
4. All previously registered participants are advised that their registration shall remain valid for the rescheduled activity. The same participants identified under the previously issued Memorandum including the services to be provided, health and registration protocols, data privacy requirements, coordination mechanisms, and other implementing guidelines, shall remain in full force and effect.
5. Unit Heads and concerned officials shall ensure the continuous delivery of essential office services and the uninterrupted performance of official functions.
6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
