**SUBJECT : MANDATORY ADHERENCE TO THE EXECUTION OF THE SCHOOL SAFETY DRILL**

**DATE : September 21, 2026**

In light of the **Nationwide School Safety Drill** held on **September 3, 2026**, all Regional and Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Coordinators are instructed to **oversee and guarantee the execution of the School Safety Drill across all schools in their Areas of Responsibility (AOR)**.

Executing the School Safety Drill and formulating contingency plans are essential preparedness measures. These activities allow schools to:

- Practice correct emergency procedures for potential safety incidents
- Evaluate the readiness of students and staff
- Pinpoint deficiencies in current safety protocols
- Enhance overall safety and emergency preparedness

Accordingly, all coordinators must actively track non-compliant schools and support their prompt completion of the drill. Following completion, schools should fill out the required evaluation form at <https://bit.ly/4iwrXhO> and resolve any identified gaps.
