DIVISION-WIDE SEARCH FOR SCALABLE INNOVATIONS

1. In support of the Department of Education's commitment to innovation, research, and continuous improvement, this Office launches the **Search for Scalable Conducted Innovations** to recognize research-based practices that have made a meaningful difference in teaching and learning and show potential to be shared, adapted, and sustained in other schools and learning settings.
2. The search will particularly highlight conducted research and innovations in Key Stage 1 implemented from School Year 2022–2023 up to the present, with a focus on strengthening foundational Literacy and Numeracy. It aims to encourage educators to share proven practices and innovations that have worked in their own contexts and have the potential to improve learner outcomes, teaching practices, and overall school performance.
3. The Search for Scalable Conducted Innovations aims to:
 - 3.1 Identify innovative practices and interventions implemented by schools, teachers, and education personnel;
 - 3.2 Recognize innovations that have generated measurable positive impacts on learners, schools, and communities;
 - 3.3 Determine innovations with strong potential for scaling, replication, and institutionalization across the division;



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3.4 Promote evidence-based decision-making and knowledge-sharing among schools and offices; and

3.5 Establish a repository of best practices and scalable innovations for wider adoption.

4. The search is open to all teaching personnel, school heads, district offices, learning centers, and functional units within the Schools Division Office of Bulacan.

5. Entries may be submitted individually or by a team in this link



6. Enclosure 1 contain the documentary requirements, evaluation criteria, and schedule of activities to guide participants in the submission and evaluation process.

7. Outstanding scalable innovations shall receive Certificate of Recognition and other awards subject to the availability of funds and existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Selected innovations may also be recommended for presentation, adoption, replication, and submission to regional and national innovation initiatives.

8. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against available division funds, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, auditing, and procurement rules and regulations. Expenses incurred by participants in the preparation of entries may be charged against local funds, subject to existing policies.

9. A Division Search Committee shall be organized to oversee the conduct, evaluation, validation, and documentation of the search and ensure compliance with established guidelines.

10. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with the provisions of this Memorandum are hereby enjoined.

Documentary Requirements

Participants shall submit the following:

1. Innovation Write-up (not more than 10 pages);
2. Executive Summary;
3. Evidence of Implementation;
4. Monitoring and Evaluation Results, where applicable; and
5. Other supporting documents demonstrating the innovation's effectiveness and scalability.

Criteria for Evaluation

Submitted innovations shall be evaluated based on the following criteria:
