**THIRD QUARTERLY MEETING OF EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. Based on the CRLA, Phil-IRI, and RMA assessment results, a significant percentage of learners in Key Stages 1, 2, and 3 remain struggling readers and non-numerate. To address learning gaps and align with the DepEd Revised K to 12 Agenda and ARAL Program, there is a need for contextualized, innovative, and sustainable reading and numeracy interventions. Hence, the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct the **Third Quarter Meeting of Education Program Supervisors and Public Schools District Supervisors on the Literacy and Numeracy Skills Interventions** on September 16, 2026, 8:30 AM at Bustos District Hall, Bustos, Bulacan.
2. The activity aims to:
 - Analyze assessment results to be used in decision -making to strengthen the literacy and numeracy skills interventions;
 - Share best practices on literacy and numeracy interventions aligned in support of the implementation of the ARAL program;
 - Discuss the challenges met in the implementation of the ARAL Program and suggest possible solutions; and
 - Plan the strategic monitoring and evaluation processes to measure impact.
