**DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON ADVANCED COMMUNICATIVE, STRATEGIC,
AND SOCIO-CULTURAL COMPETENCE DEVELOPMENT FOR ENGLISH TEACHERS**

1. To further enhance and strengthen the communicative competence, strategic language use, and socio-cultural awareness of Junior High School English Master Teachers and Teachers as effective language educators capable of fostering meaningful communication, promoting culturally responsive teaching practices, and improving learning outcomes, this Office shall conduct the **Division Training-Workshop on Advanced Communicative, Strategic, and Socio-Cultural Competence Development for English Teachers** on **September 9–11, 2026**, at Galilee Wonderland Resort, Bustos, Bulacan.
2. This training-workshop has the following objectives:
 - 2.1 enhance the teacher-participants' proficiency in communicative competence by equipping them with innovative teaching strategies and techniques that promote effective oral and written communication skills of their Junior High School learners;
 - 2.2 develop the participants' strategic language use and socio-cultural awareness, enabling them to integrate culturally responsive practices and strategic learning activities into their classroom instruction; and
 - 2.3 improve the participants' ability to design and implement engaging lesson plans and assessment tools that incorporate socio-cultural and strategic communication components, thereby fostering a more inclusive and dynamic learning environment.
3. Each secondary school shall send one (1) Junior High School (JHS) English Teacher to participate in the training, while all JHS English Master Teachers shall also be included as participants.
4. Enclosure No.1 contains the matrix of activities, including the resource speakers, facilitators, and the chair and members of the Program Management Team (PMT).
5. All participants are advised to bring laptops and gadgets with data for WIFI connections to be used during the simulation and workshop sessions.
6. Expenses to be incurred in the conduct of this activity shall be taken from the Division INSET funds, while the school's local funds shall be utilized for the transportation expenses of the participants, both subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. This Memorandum serves as the travel authority for the participants involved in this activity.
