1. The Consultative Meeting on Training Orientation for the National Assessments and various Assessment-Related Activities aims to strengthen the capacity of school and division personnel in the effective planning, preparation, administration, monitoring, and evaluation of national and large-scale assessments conducted by the Department of Education. Hence, this Office shall conduct a **Consultative Meeting on Training Orientation for the National Assessment** on September 25, 2026, at 8:30 am at a venue to be announced later. Through consultative discussions, participants shall collaboratively identify issues and challenges encountered during previous assessment activities, including concerns related to digital assessment implementation, and recommend appropriate strategies to improve the integrity, efficiency, accessibility, security, and reliability of future assessment administrations.

 - e. Address Assessment-Related Gaps
 - f. Strengthen Professional Development



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- g. Promote Assessment Integrity and Accountability
 - h. Enhance Data Utilization
 - i. Strengthen Technical and Operational Readiness
 - j. Develop Actionable Recommendations
3. Participants in this activity are as follows:
- Elementary Group
- 1 School Head – Testing Adviser from 31 Districts
 - 2 School Head Representatives from 31 Districts (to be identified by the Public Schools District Supervisors)
 - 7 PMT, including Resource Speakers
 - Total Participants: 100 pax
- Secondary Group
- 100 School Heads
 - 8 Members of the TWG and secretariat
 - Total Participants: 108 personnel
4. Meal expenses shall be charged against the **Downloaded Fund for Testing/Assessment**, while transportation expenses shall be charged against the school local fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
