**PARTICIPATION IN THE 2026 NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY CULMINATING
ACTIVITY**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 225, s. 2026, and in line with Proclamation No. 242, s. 2011 declaring September 5 to October 5 of every year as National Teachers' Month, the Department of Education, through the External Partnerships Service (EPS) and the National Teachers' Month Coordinating Council (NTMCC), will conduct the 2026 National Teachers' Day Culminating Activity on October 5, 2026 at the Smart Araneta Coliseum, Cubao, Quezon City.
2. The activity serves as the culminating nationwide gathering of the month-long celebration, recognizing the vital role, invaluable contributions, inspiring stories, and achievements of teachers in shaping the lives of learners and the future of the nation. DepEd Region III has been allotted 1,500 participant slots, with a significant number of participants allocated to each Schools Division Office.
3. Accordingly, the Schools Division of Bulacan shall participate in the said activity through its official delegation. The list of participants is contained in Enclosure No. 1 to this Memorandum.
4. All identified participants are advised to coordinate with their respective offices/schools and comply with the necessary administrative, travel, and activity requirements. Travel and other incidental expenses relative to the activity shall be charged against the School MOOE, Division MOOE, or available local funds, subject to existing DepEd policies and the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

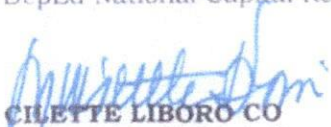

The Department of Education (DepEd) shall conduct the **National Teachers' Day (NTD) Culminating Activity on 5 October, 2026 at the Smart Araneta Coliseum, Cubao, Quezon City.**

This program culminates the month-long celebration for teachers pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242, s. 2011 "Declaring the period from 5 September to 5 October of Every Year as National Teachers' Month (NTM)," and Republic Act No. 10743, otherwise known as the "Declaring the 5th Day of October of Every Year as the National Teachers' Day (NTD)", its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and the designation of the World Teachers' Day (WTD), every 5th of October by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

As part of this year's NTM celebration, special regional events will be held to honor and highlight the diverse contributions of teachers across the country. NTM Kick off Program will be on 5 September 2026 at Limketkei Center, Cagayan de Oro City, while the NTM Mid-Month will be held on 19 September 2026 at Tacloban City Astrodome, Tacloban City.

These celebrations showcase the unique stories, cultures, and achievements of teachers in their respective regions and serve as a prelude to the culminating celebration in Luzon.

The NTM celebration will conclude with a nationwide gathering of teachers from Luzon, together with key stakeholders, to collectively honor and celebrate their invaluable contributions.
