**DIVISION ORIENTATION ON SCHOOL-INITIATED INTERVENTION
PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION FOR SUSTAINABLE EDUCATION**

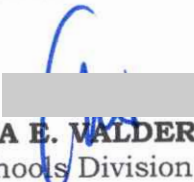

1. In support of the Department of Education's continuing commitment to promote learning continuity, equity, and access to quality education, and in accordance with Republic Act No. 10533, or the *Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013*, and Republic Act No. 10121, or the *Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010*, the implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) remains an essential strategy in mitigating learning disruptions caused by emergencies and disasters. Building on the knowledge, experiences, and outputs developed during the first phase of the training, this activity aims to further enhance the competencies of Supervisors, School Heads, and Teachers in strengthening the effective implementation of ADM. The training will emphasize collaborative planning, school-community coordination, preparedness and response mechanisms, and context-responsive strategies for education delivery. Through these efforts, participants will be better equipped to lead and support initiatives that ensure the continued provision of meaningful, accessible, inclusive, and quality learning opportunities for learners, particularly those affected by emergencies, disasters, and environmental hazards.
2. In this regard, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the conduct of the Division Orientation on School-Initiated Intervention Program Implementation for Sustainable Education on September 10 to 11, 2026 at the venue to be announced and on September 12, 2026, via an online session. The virtual platform link will be forwarded directly to the official ADM group chat.



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3. This training aims to enable participants to:
 - 3.1 enhance the capacity of school heads, teachers, and program implementers in planning, developing, and implementing school-initiated intervention programs that address identified learner and school needs;
 - 3.2 strengthen participants' knowledge and skills in designing evidence-based, context-responsive, and sustainable intervention strategies that support learning continuity, learner achievement, and school improvement; and
 - 3.3 equip participants with effective approaches in monitoring, evaluating, documenting, and sustaining school-initiated intervention programs in alignment with DepEd policies, priorities, and quality standards.
4. Expenses for meals, snacks, and other incidental costs related to the conduct of the orientation shall be charged to ADM Program Support Funds. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to school MOOE, Special Education Funds (SEF), and other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

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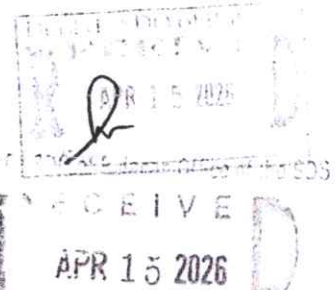
